

## **Performance Requirements for SOL**

For performances we require:

- a clear, dry space no less than 10m wide x 8m deep for the musicians, conductor & soloist (total c. 38-42 performers).
- appropriate room for the audience to be comfortable (either sitting or standing)
- indoor or outdoor spaces are equally fine for our performances
- we always perform standing, this is part of our performance style

## **Weather conditions**

If performing outside, a wet-weather contingency should ideally be in place. A performance cannot take place in wet weather or if rain/drizzle is expected within c.30mins of the scheduled start of a performance (we monitor the weather carefully with forecast apps). Very windy conditions can also prove challenging but we always persevere to make it work.

## Set Up

The orchestra is entirely self-sufficient and aims to set up/pack down in c.10mins. The group plays standing and we don't require music stands or chairs or power. We travel in a 49-seater coach and if possible we request a reserved space where we can park, or advice on drop-off/nearby parking.

We typically set up in the formation shown below, although we can adapt this to play in more unusual locations.
